# Our Lady of Fatima Apparitions in Portugal in 1-10

Once upon a time, a pope called Benedict XV (fifteen) organised a crusade of prayers to Mary as the mediator of all graces, to save the world then devastated by the First World War. A week later, his anguished prayer was answered by the Virgin Mary. One Sunday, 13 May 1917, three children were tending their sheep in the hills of Fatima, Portugal. Lucia, aged 10, and her cousins Francisco and Jacinta, aged 9 and 7 respectively, were the lucky ones chosen by the Virgin.

Hearing midday sound at a distance, they knelt down and said the rosary. Their prayer was interrupted by the sight of a flash of lightning, then a second flash brighter than the first. But the sky was cloudless. O marvellous! they saw a beautiful Lady more sparkling than the sun. Terrified, the three children wanted to run away, but the mysterious apparition reassured them with a gesture of maternal kindness and said: « Don't be afraid, I won't hurt you.

After a few minutes of silence, Lucia dared to ask: « Who are you? – I am from heaven, » replied the heavenly vision, « I have come down to ask you to come here, six months in a row, on the 13th of each month. » The Virgin recommended that they pray the rosary often.

"You will add this prayer after the Gloria Patri: "O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, preserve us from the fire of hell, and lead to heaven all souls, especially those most in need of Thy mercy". Then She fell silent and gently departed. Every 13th of the following five months, the children had the distinct joy of seeing the beautiful Lady again. News of the apparitions spread rapidly through the region. On 13 July, the crowd of onlookers reached five thousand, and by August it had risen to almost twenty thousand. Finally, on 13 October, around seventy thousand people turned out despite the rain.

Suddenly, the sky lightened, the sun shook and began to turn on itself at dizzying speed. The three children saw the Blessed Virgin accompanied this time by Jesus and St Joseph. This miracle took place exactly on the day, at the time and in the place announced, to encourage people to believe in the reality of the apparitions and to obey the message that the Blessed Virgin was bringing from Heaven. At Fatima, as at Lourdes, Our Lady recommended penance and the recitation of the rosary. "If you respond to my request to do penance and pray, Russia will be converted and you will have peace," promised the Virgin Mary. "If not, she will spread her errors throughout the world, bringing war and persecution to the Church. The good will be martyred, the Holy Father will have much to suffer , many nations will be devastated." But let's not forget that Our Lady of Fatima added: "In the end, My Immaculate Heart will triumph."
