THE STORY: Charles de Foucauld


Once upon a time, there was a little boy named Charles. He had not always been nice and sometimes did huge stupid things. His parents were probably wondering how he would end. As a young man, he did not change and led a life of debauchery. He loved to travel and as an explorer, he visited many countries. It is then that he makes a dazzling encounter with Christ. Now he travels for Christ. In January 1897, to meet a demand for absolute deprivation and poverty, Charles left the Trappe of Akbès. He went to Palestine to lead a hermit life. On March 6, 1897, he pushed the door of the chapel of the convent of the Poor Clares in Nazareth. He stayed there for more than two years, leading the life of a valet, helping with the garden and small works. He accepted for accommodation only a hut of planks in which the tools were stored in the garden. He devoted himself to prayer, in his hut or in the chapel, and to writing. He then imposed on himself a life of great austerity, poorly dressed, eating little, giving the poor the little he had, thanking the Lord for having "plunged him into the abjection after which he sighed. Valet of the Poor Clares in the very city where Jesus grew up, poorer than the poorest, forgotten and hidden in the very places where his master lived ignored thirty years, he was wonderfully answered". A miracle recognized by the Vatican is the incredible story of a young carpenter from Saumur (Maine-et-Loire), survivor in 2016 of a fall of 15 m from which he emerged unscathed, despite an abdomen pierced from part by a piece of wood from a bench

Here is the prayer of Charles de Foucauld

My Father, I surrender to you, do with me what you please. Whatever you do with me,

thank you. I am ready for anything, I accept everything. As long as your will is in me, in all your creatures, I desire nothing else, my God. I put my soul in your hands. I give it to you, my God,

with all the love of my heart, because I love you, and it is a need of love for me to give myself, to put me in your hands, without measure, with infinite confidence,
